Estatetter No. 457/6/INST/2014/CC&BE, dated F0573:2014 addressed to the Cabinet Secretary, Chief Secretaries and Chief Electoral Officers of all States and UTs.

Subject: Instructions relating to deletion of all references on politicians/Ministers on the official website during election period of General/Bye election to the LokSabha and

Lam directed to state that the Commission yide its letter No. 437/6/2007 (INST)-PLN/III, dated 21st November, 2007, issued instructions to deletion of all references on politicians/Ministers on the official website during election period of General/Bye elections to the LokSabha and State Legislative Assemblies.

It has come to the notice of the Commission that the aloresaid instructions of the Commission are not being followed by Central and State Governments during election period. It is clearly mentioned in clause VII (iv) of Model Code of Conduct for guidance of Poline department and

## "VII. Party in Power

The party in power whether at the Centre of in the State or States concerned, shall ensure that no cause is given for any complaint that it has used its official position for the purpose of its

(iv) Issues of advertisement at the cost of public exchequer in the newspapers and other media and the misuse of official mass media during the election period for partisan coverage of political news and publicity regarding achievaments with a view to furthering the prospects of the party in power shall be scrupulously avoided."

The Commission has considered the question of various references currently available in the Ministerial office website and in the State Government websites pertaining to several Department and Government Organization highlighting their achievements but culogizing the same as personal achievements of Politicians/Ministers.

The Commission has decided that during the period when Model Code of Conduct is in force in connection with General Election to the Loksabha/State Legislative Assemblies currently going on, all references of Ministers, Politicians or Political Parties available on such Central/ State Government's official website, shall be removed.

Subject: Instructions relating to deletion of all references on politicians/Ministers on the official website during election period of General / Bye-Elections to the LokSabha and State Legislative Assemblies – regarding.

I am directed to state that the Commission has considered the question of various references currently available in the State Government websites/Ministerial official websites pertaining to several Department and Govt. Organization highlighting their achievements but eulogizing the same as personal achievements of Politicians / Ministers. The Commission has decided that during the period when model code of conduct is in force in connection with general election to the LokSabha /State Legislative Assemblies, all references to Ministers, Politicians or Political Parties available on such State Government /Central Government 's official websites, shall betaken off/ purged of. During bye-elections, these instructions may be confined to only those Politicians/Ministers, etc. who themselves become andidates at such bye- elections.

This may kindly be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.

#### CIRCULAR

Sub:- General Administration Department - General Election to Lok Sabha
2019- Conduct of Government Servants - Guidelines- Regarding.

Ref:- 1767(14)/EL4/2019/Elec dated 16/03/2019 from Chief Electoral Officer, Kerala.

The Election Commission of India has instructed that the MCC came into force with effect from 10/03/2019 in connection with General Election to Lok Sabha 2019. Accordingly State Government has drawn up a list of do's and don'ts to be followed by the Government Officials after the announcement of the election and till the completion of the process of election. The following directions /instructions must be strictly adhered to.

- All Government Employees are instructed to refrain from activities like engaging
  in disseminating contents having issues related to political parties, which tantamount
  to election propaganda through social media, failing which strict disciplinary action
  will be initiated against such Government employees.
- 2) It enjoins upon the Government Officials at all levels that they should maintain an attitude of strict impartiality in relation to election, that they should not only be impartial but should also be seen to be independent, neutral and impartial on all matters relating to the elections, that they should treat all parties and candidates equally, fairly and justly, and that no Government officials should do any act (other than the giving of vote) which could be interpreted as furthering the prospects of any party or candidates at the election.
- 3) Government officials are strictly not to lend their names, official position or authority to assist one individual as against another or one group as against another.

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- 4) The Government officers should not themselves organise any election meetings or be present in person during any such meeting except only such officers who may have to be present to the extent necessary for maintaining law and order and making the necessary security arrangements
- 5) No Government Servants shall be a member of or be otherwise associated with, any political party or any organisation which takes part in politics nor shall be take part in, subscribe in aid of, or assist in any other manner, any political movement or activity.
- 6) No Government servants shall canvass or otherwise interfere with or use his influence in connection with or take part in an election to any Legislative or Local Authority.
- 7) Government servants shall refrain from violating Government Servant's Conduct Rules / Criminal Procedure Code / Representation of People Act 1951.
